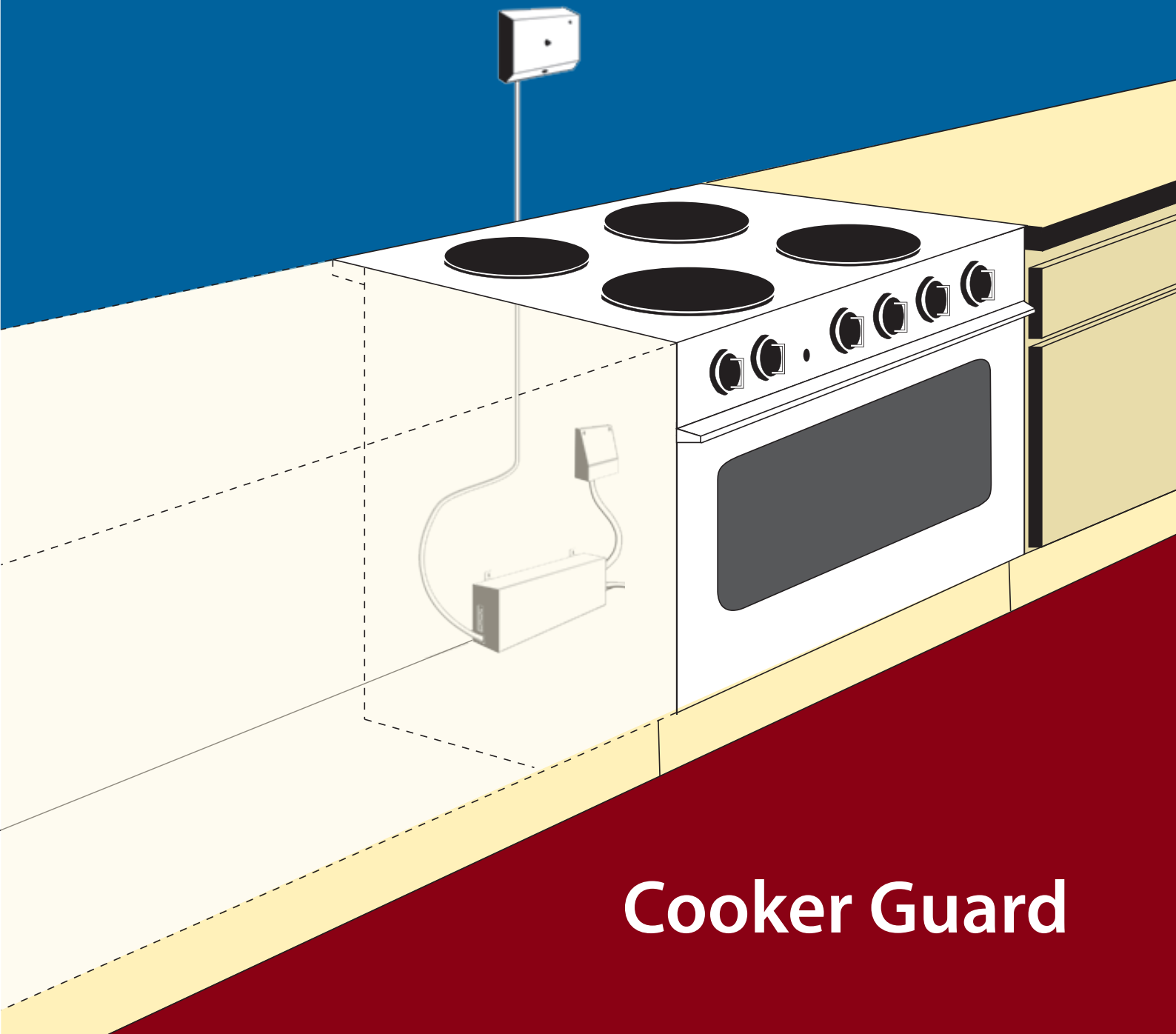


Mrs. Smith Forgot the Cooker. Who Turns it off?
